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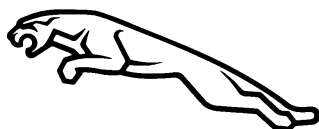

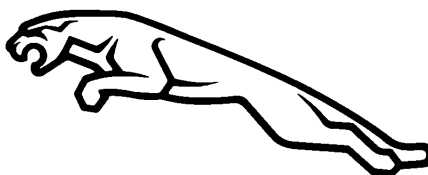
November

Coming Events

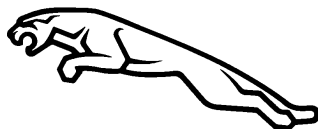

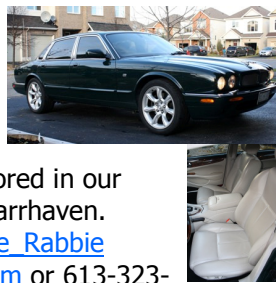

A/C was working 2 summers ago (Duracool). Dash has usual time-crackled finish (kit available, or just use teak oil). Driver's mirror remote sometimes not. Connection loose? New oil pressure sender reads lower than actual. Bonnet left side hinge bracket has some play. Rear brakes? (Should probably do pads/rotors all around.) Drips oil at rear

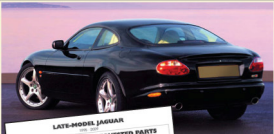

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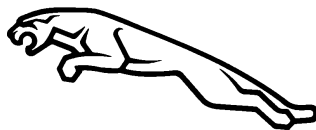
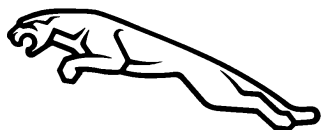
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
